Chinese Language Proficiency Policy

Language proficiency requirements are admission requirements and may not be waived by either the institution or the student.

Evidence of Chinese proficiency is required upon admission by meeting **one** of the following:

- 1. Completion of 3 years of full-time secondary education (Grades 8-12) from a country where Chinese is one of the principal languages
- 2. Completion of 2 years of full-time post-secondary education at an accredited institution where Chinese is the language of instruction
- **3.** Accepted Chinese Language Proficiency assessment test score: A minimum level 3 overall score on the Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi (HSK) administered by Ministry of Education of China.
